The Department of Education, Advanced Education in partnership with Skills Canada Yukon offer trades camps to youth ages 11 to 15 to explore the industry and gain hands on experience using tools of the trade. Guest speakers and instructors assist camps offering expert advice and instructional tips to youth on how to improve, build and design their soap box racer. Each camp ends with a race day and BBQ, where each team can race their master craft seeing if it performs as design had suggested. The camps are challenging, fun and are combined with extra curricular recreational activities to offer breaks from the stress of building the ultimate racing machine. Get involved this summer and test your building creativity.

Camp Details: REGISTRATION BEGINS June 1, 2006 8:30 am

- The camps run Monday to Friday beginning at 9am and ending at 3:00pm. **Students are only supervised from 9am to 3:00pm.**
- Students will meet at 9:00 at the Skills Canada Yukon building and should be dressed suitably for the workshop (long hair tied back, no open toe shoes, no skirts/dresses and no baggy clothing).
- Students are required to bring a bag lunch for a supervised lunch hour. Exception to this is on Friday, as lunch is provided.
- Transportation to and from all field trips and recreational planned activities is provided.
- Each student will be assigned his or her workstation and in pairs for the duration of the camp. Since only one soap box racer is built between two people a decision will be made on which student can take the racer home with them, less the hardware.
- Friday is BBQ and RACE Day filled with activities, racing and TONS OF FUN!
