Acquisition of assets

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Newcap Inc. for authority to acquire from 3937844 Canada Inc., a subsidiary of Newcap Inc., the assets of the new FM radio programming undertaking approved in *FM radio station in Camrose*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2003-615, 19 December 2003 (Decision 2003-615)¹.
- 2. The applicant stated that it filed the present application in order to correct the error it had made in the original application, approved in Decision 2003-615, which should have been filed on behalf of Newcap Inc., not on behalf of its subsidiary 3937844 Canada Inc.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with the present application.
- 4. The Commission has not yet issued a broadcasting licence for this undertaking because the requirements for the issuance of the licence have not yet been met. As stated in Decision 2003-615, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, no licence may issued until the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued. Furthermore, the licence will be issued once the applicant has informed the Commission in writing that it is prepared to commence operations.
- 5. The licence will expire 31 August 2010, the same expiry date as set out in Decision 2003-615, and will be subject to the same terms and conditions as those specified in that decision.
