CJVR-FM Melfort – New transmitter in Carrot River

1. The Commission **approves** the application by Radio CJVR Ltd. (Radio CJVR) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CJVR-FM Melfort in order to operate a transmitter in Carrot River.
2. The new transmitter will operate at 99.7 MHz (channel 259LP) with an effective radiated power of 44.78 watts.
3. Radio CJVR indicated that although the current signal reaches the general area of Carrot River, it is sporadic, and that the new transmitter will improve signal reception for the residents of this community.
4. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
5. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
6. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
7. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected FM service, the Commission also reminds the licensee that it will have to select another channel if the Department so requires.

8. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 16 August 2008. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
