CHYR-FM Leamington – Technical changes

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Blackburn Radio Inc. to change the authorized contours of the English-language commercial radio programming undertaking CHYR-FM Leamington, by decreasing the average effective radiated power from 19,320 watts to 10,650 watts, by increasing the antenna height and by relocating the transmitter.
- The applicant stated that the proposed changes will improve the signal quality for listeners residing in Essex County, who currently experience poor reception of CHYR-FM.
- 3. The Commission received interventions in support of this application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
