## **CBAX-FM Halifax - New transmitter in Yarmouth**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBAX-FM Halifax, in order to operate a transmitter in Yarmouth.
- 2. The licensee proposed to add an FM transmitter in Yarmouth to broadcast the programming of CBAX-FM Halifax in order to serve the population of Yarmouth. The new transmitter will operate at 106.1 MHz (channel 291B) with an average effective radiated power of 20,500 watts.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Department of Industry (the Department) has advised the Commission that, while this application is conditionally technically acceptable, it will only issue a broadcasting certificate when it has determined that the proposed technical parameters will not create any unacceptable interference with aeronautical NAV/COM services.
- 5. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
