## **CBA-FM Moncton – Technical change**

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, the licensee of the radio programming undertaking CBH-FM Halifax, to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CBA-FM Moncton, by decreasing the effective radiated power from 77,000 watts to 68,000 watts and by increasing the antenna height.
- 2. The licensee advised that it had replaced its transmission tower near Moncton in the fall of 2005. The technical change is necessary to maintain the same coverage area.
- The Commission notes that there will be no significant change to the authorized contours.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
