CHNU-TV Fraser Valley and its transmitter in Victoria – Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Rogers Broadcasting Limited, the licensee of the television programming undertaking, CHNU-TV Fraser Valley (known as OMNI BC), to change the authorized contours of the transmitter authorized in *CHNU-TV Fraser Valley, CIIT-TV Winnipeg Acquisition of assets, new transmitter in Victoria, and new licences*, Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2005-207, 20 May 2005, by relocating the transmitter, by decreasing the antenna height, and by increasing the average effective radiated power from 720 watts to 17,000 watts.
- 2. The licensee indicated that the new site will improve the potential reliability of OMNI BC's signal and improve efficiencies in the construction of the antenna site.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
