CJMT-DT Toronto – New transmitter in Ottawa

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Rogers Broadcasting Limited to amend the broadcasting licence for the transitional digital television programming undertaking CJMT-DT Toronto, in order to operate a transmitter in Ottawa.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate on channel 66C with an average effective radiated power of 7,110 watts.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 19 May 2007. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
