



## Broadcasting Decision CRTC 2005-71

### **CBUT-35 Sechelt – Technical Change**

1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for its television programming undertaking CBUT Vancouver, in order to change the channel of its transmitter CBUT-35 Sechelt from 19LP to 18LP.
2. The CBC stated that the use of channel 18LP will provide a better quality signal to listeners in the Sechelt area who are currently experiencing poor reception of CBUT Vancouver.
3. The Commission received an intervention in support of this application and a comment, which commended the CBC's service to Canadians.
4. The Commission reminds the applicant that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry (the Department) notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
5. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected television service, the Commission also reminds the applicant that it will have to select another channel if the Department so requires.
