CBKT Regina and its transmitter CBKT-6 Yorkton - Technical change

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation to change the authorized contours of its transmitter CBKT-6 Yorkton, by decreasing the effective radiated power from 54,600 watts to 50,200 watts and by increasing the antenna height.
- 2. The Commission notes that this change reflects the actual technical parameters following construction of the transmission facilities and that there will be no significant change to the coverage area.
- 3. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
