CBAF-FM-15 Charlottetown – New transmitter at Urbainville

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC) to amend the broadcasting licence for the radio programming undertaking CBAF-FM-15 Charlottetown in order to operate a transmitter at Urbainville to rebroadcast the programming of its national French-language network service La Première Chaîne.
- 2. The new transmitter will operate at 106.9 MHz (channel 295A1) with an effective radiated power of 173 watts.
- 3. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that, pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met, and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 21 November 2007. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
