
**RE: Follow-up to Telecom Decision CRTC 2002-34 – Adjustments to
Category I Competitor Service rates to reflect the application of the
I-X constraint Tariff Issuance:
TCI Tariffs CRTC 21461/21462/18001/18008/25271/1005/1017**

Pursuant to paragraph 445 of Telecom Decision CRTC 2002-34 ("Decision 2002-34), TELUS Communications Inc. ("TCI" or the "Company") attaches a copy of the Check Sheets (8 pages) and the affected tariff pages (61 pages) reflecting the application of the I-X constraint, effective 2005 06 01.

In addition, pursuant to paragraph 48 of Telecom Decision CRTC 2003-13, TCI attaches its "Tracking of Tariff Items at Two Decimal Places" to keep track of the rates rounded to four decimal places in order to determine the appropriate rates for services in subsequent years. The four-digit rate is then to be truncated to two decimal places for the tariff.

With respect to TCBC Tariff CRTC 1005, Page 796-C.2A (Item 197-A), the Company added a new Note ψ to explain the basis of its rate calculations for the 2005 annual I-X rates specified on that page. This note is added because the Company had inadvertently omitted to update the I-X affected rates on Original Page 796-C.2A with the 2004, June 1 I-X rate reductions when the Company issued the approved Original Page 796-C.2A on 22 November 2004. This oversight affected the tariff record only and has no impact on customer bills as all customers were billed at the correct 2004 I-X rates for the period from 1 June 2004 to end of May 2005.

Rates

The Customer shall pay to TCI the following rates and charges for the Integrated Voice Messaging - Underlying Network Components. Such rates and charges are in addition to any other rates and charges that may be applicable.

1. Integrated Voice Messaging - Underlying Network Components

2. The voice messaging service provider shall pay the Centrex Network Access line rate for each circuit provided to the voice messaging service provider's Voice Messaging System and for each Centrex Simplified Message Desk Interface port required per Item 585.
3. Where applicable, the Local Channel Charge from the Central Office to the voice messaging service provider's Voice Messaging System location will be assessed pursuant to General Tariff (CRTC 21461), Item 522, Analogue Private Line Services.
4. Local Channel Conditioning required to furnish Local Channel Facilities will be provided, as necessary, at no charge

§ Application of the 2005 I-X constraint did not result in a change to this rate.
