1. Pursuant to Aliant Telecom's ("Aliant" or "the Company") letter of 2005 09 19, the Company wishes to advise the Commission and parties to this proceeding where references have been made in its submissions to the findings from the NBI/Michael Sone Associates, Canadian Local Telecommunications Services Market Report, 2004 Edition, November 2004 report. There is only one such reference, namely at paragraph 34 of the Attachment 1 of Aliant's June 22, 2005 submission. In this paragraph, the Company noted that: "NBI/Michael Sone Associates also predict substantial growth in VoIP residential subscriber numbers. By the end of 2007, 9% of residential subscribers in Canada will be VoIP customers, of which 73% is expected to be held by cable companies and other non-ILECs", and cited the NBI/Sone Associates report as the source for this statement.
