Ms. Linda Gobeil was appointed as Senior Vice-President, Policy Branch, Public Service Commission of Canada on June 7, 2005. The Policy Branch provides knowledge, intelligence, insight and advice to support the PSC's ability to champion an independent, professional and representative public service.

Prior to her appointment with the PSC, Ms. Gobeil was with Social Development Canada for two years, most recently as Assistant Deputy Minister, Human Resources, and Finance and Administrative Services.

In October 2001, Ms. Gobeil was appointed Assistant Secretary, Machinery of Government, at the Privy Council Office, where she was instrumental in the Machinery of Government and Human Resources aspects of the enactment of the *Public Service Modernization Act*.

From 1999 to 2001, Ms. Gobeil held the positions of Assistant Commissioner, Appeals Branch and Assistant Commissioner, Human Resources Branch, at the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency.

From 1996 to 1999, Ms. Gobeil held the position of Assistant Secretary, Labour Relations, Human Resources Branch, at the Treasury Board Secretariat, where she was responsible for the collective bargaining and other key human resources files.

From 1995 to 1996, Ms. Gobeil was Executive Assistant/Special Advisor to the Deputy Minister of Justice and from 1986 to 1995, Justice Counsel assigned to Treasury Board Legal Services.

Ms. Gobeil holds a Bachelor of General Arts and a Bachelor of Law, both from the University of Ottawa. She was admitted as a member of the Quebec Bar Association in 1983.
