

Designated Trainer Work Experience Application *Trade of Ironworker*

NOTE: Effective April 1, 2003, all NEW applicants wanting trades training as apprentices must work under the supervision of a certified journeyman unless a specific Trade Regulation provides accommodation for an alternate arrangement.

The **Trade Regulation for Ironworker** allows a provision to use a designated trainer (an experienced trades-person without journeyman certification) to supervise the work of and train an apprentice. The training arrangement between a designated trainer and apprentice in this trade is valid until **November 1, 2006**. At that time there should be sufficient numbers of certified journeymen available to supervise and train new apprentices entering the trade.

To qualify as a designated trainer in this trade, you must have:

- experience in 70 per cent of the tasks of the trade
- at least 4 1/2 years of work experience in the trade within the last ten years

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Erection of Structural Ironwork <i>Includes:</i> assembling, installing and erecting; -structural steel framework for buildings, bridges and towers, metal storage tanks, bins and hoppers; -curtain walls, window walls, doorways, store fronts, revolving doors, mantraps etc., in or on buildings; -ornamental and miscellaneous ironwork such as stairways railings etc., precast concrete components for building and other structures; inspecting/testing structures and equipment; and -dismantling building framework, tanks, silos etc. 	%
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Reinforcing Concrete <i>Includes:</i> positioning and securing steel bar or wire mesh reinforcing prior to pouring concrete for grade beams, footings, walls, floors etc.; and - post-tensions tendons in cast-in-place or precast concrete. 	%
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Rigging and Moving Machinery <i>Includes:</i> preparing wire and fibre ropes and tackle; and - rigging and moving loads. 	%
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Erection of Hoisting and Conveyance Equipment <i>Includes:</i> assembling, erecting, jumping and dismantling tower, conventional and hydraulic cranes, various derrick types, personnel hoists; and - installing support structures, frameworks and related structural and mechanical equipment for conveying and material handling systems. 	%
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Erection of Scaffold, Falsework & Other Working Platforms <i>Includes:</i> erecting temporary frame or tube scaffolds, falsework, shoring etc; -and suspending scaffolds from structures. 	%
