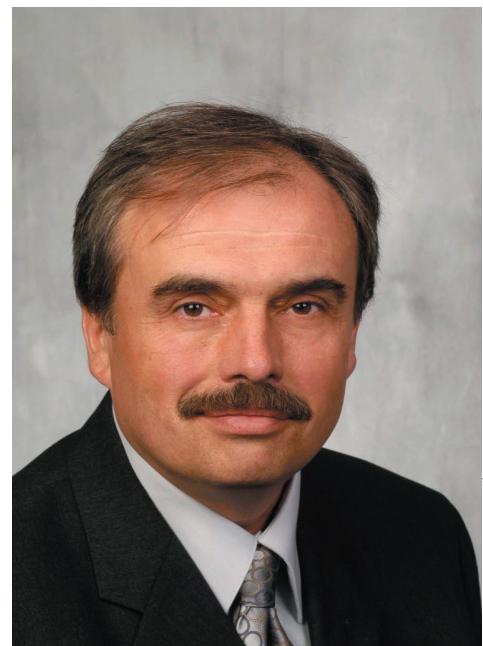
The Property Registry continues to meet their performance targets.

I am pleased to present the ninth Annual Report of The Property Registry for the 2005/2006 Fiscal Year.

This report provides an overview of the Agency and outlines the accomplishments during the ninth year of operations as a Special Operating Agency.

Revenues and volumes of transactions with the Agency continued to be strong, with a robust real estate market in the City of Winnipeg. Turn-around time for registrations remained acceptable.

Significant achievements for the year included:

- Continuation of the Agency's Employee Succession Project.
- Continuation of the Records Preservation Project. Over 1,500,000 documents have been filmed to date.
