I would like to advise you of some changes to the Manitoba Health STD Drug program:

1. From this point forward STD drug orders should be faxed directly to **Tache Pharmacy at (204) 231-1739**. Their contact information is on the *STD Medication Order Form* included in this package of information.
2. The *STD Medication Order Form* has been revised to more accurately reflect the publicly-funded drugs available for treatment of selected STDs, and their indications.
3. Included is an updated *STD Treatment Guidelines* desk reference to assist you in your selection of required medications.
