(Your Pre-study Period is either the 4 months before your studies begin or the period between full-time studies, if it is less than 4 months. Example: for students graduating from high school, the Pre-Study Period would be approximately July 1-Sept.1.)

- **Contact information of a parent, next-of-kin or other contact person (name, address, postal code, phone number)**

- **Course-load** _____ % (Minimum course-load is 60% in each term, except for Private Vocational Schools where applicants must take 100%. Typically, 100% in most university faculties is 15 credit hours per term; 60% would therefore be 9 credit hours per term. Contact your school if unsure of your course-load.)
