



Seven steps you can take to successfully implement amendments to *The Non-Smokers Health Protection Act*

- 1. Post the required **No Smoking** signs by Oct. 1, 2004.
- 2. Make copies of the fact sheet outlining the dangers created by second-hand smoke available to both customers and staff.
- 3. Make sure that all staff are aware of *The Non-Smokers Health Protection Act* and how to deal with customers who may be smoking.
- 4. Remove all indoor ashtrays and cigarette receptacles by Oct. 1, 2004.
- 5. Provide containers outside your business for discarded cigarettes.
- 6. Display tabletop tent cards prominently in your establishment.
