

Freshwater Fish
Marketing Act (Canada)

Freshwater Fish Marketing Act prohibits exports other than as authorized by FFMC As granted in The Fisheries Act (MB) FFMC can authorize fish marketing in MB (special Dealer's Licence) FFMC/others need to meet Consumer Packaging and Labelling Act requirements

Sole control re: authority for interprovincial & international fish sales
