

The Province of Manitoba and Government of Canada share responsibilities regarding business people immigrating to Canada through the Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program for Business.

The Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program for Business allows Manitoba to recruit and nominate qualified business people from around the world who have the intent and ability to move to **Manitoba** and establish or purchase a business. To qualify for the program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum personal net worth of CDN \$250,000.
- Minimum investment of CDN \$150,000 to start a new business, buy an existing business or invest in and take an active role in the management of a business in Manitoba.
- Minimum 3 years of successful business ownership experience or extensive experience in senior management of a company.
- Have conducted a visit to Manitoba prior to applying to investigate business opportunities and Manitoba's quality of life.



Manitoba would like to accept all applicants who meet the program criteria for nomination. However, our agreement with the Government of Canada limits the number of

immigrants that we may nominate each year. Given this limitation, Manitoba will select the applicants who best meet the qualifications and who offer the most to Manitoba. As we still welcome all business immigrants who arrive in Manitoba, we would encourage you to consider your eligibility to apply under Canada Immigration's Business Immigration Program for entrepreneurs and the self-employed with Manitoba as your destination.

How to Apply for the Manitoba **Provincial Nominee Program** for Business

Step #1

Contact the Manitoba Department of Industry, Economic Development & Mines (IEDM) to obtain an Application Kit for the Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program for Business. You also have the option of downloading the Application Kit from our website (www.manitoba-canada.com/pnp-b). For information on Manitoba's economy and business opportunities, contact IEDM or visit our website at www.manitoba-canada.com.

Step #2

Submit your application for the Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program for Business to IEDM.

Step #3

If your application is accepted for nomination, you will be required to sign a Deposit Agreement (contract) and make a deposit of \$75,000 into a bank account in Manitoba. You will forward your original Federal Immigration Forms and Landing Fees to IEDM. IEDM will then forward the package to the appropriate Canadian Embassy.

Step #4

The Canadian Embassy will review the file, conduct a security and a health check, and may request an interview. Upon favourable results, they will issue your Permanent Visa.

Step #5

Upon arrival in Manitoba, contact IEDM to receive settlement and business information. Once your investment has been verified in the business area you have proposed, your \$75,000 deposit will be returned to you. Any changes to the Deposit Agreement must be discussed and approved by IEDM before proceeding with your business.

Manitoba encourages people from all over the

world to settle in our province. We invite you to take advantage of an extensive network of services available to newcomers. The Manitoba Provincial Nominee Program for Business allows us to assist you in the immigration process.
