







Manitoba Hog & Cattle Production 1960-2000




Projected Manitoba Hog Numbers by 2060



Manitoba Hog & Cattle Production 1960-2000


















New Ontario Legislation


Includes all nutrient sources -- commercial fertilizer, manure, municipal biosolids

Phase-in depending on farm size

Manure vs. commercial

- 18 million tons of manure produced annually
- Estimated fertilizer contribution:
 - 290 million lb of N
 - 40 million lb of P
 - 100 million lb of K.
- Annual value of manure roughly \$131 million (1995 prices).
 - Estimated annual of commercial fertilizer \$286 million (1995)
- Almost 50% of the value of commercial fertilizer applied in Manitoba
