



Creating a Children's Book

Student Worksheet 8: Putting the Book Together

When putting your book together remember these important points:

- **If you are using glue, *before you use it*, put the text and picture on the page to see how it looks.**
- **Be careful with glue!** It can spoil your page and stick different pages together. **Do not stack your pages until the glue is dry.**
- If you are punching holes in card or construction paper, take your time and do it right. **One improperly punched hole can ruin a page.**
- **Do not put the book together until absolutely everything else is done.** Here is a final checklist:

Front cover done, with title and author(s)/illustrator(s) names?	<input type="checkbox"/>
End papers on the inside covers?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Pages numbered?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Text glued in?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Main pictures/illustrations?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Is the glue dry?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Holes properly punched?	<input type="checkbox"/>
Everything else?	<input type="checkbox"/>
