CUSTOMS NOTICE N-567

Certain Filter-Tipped Cigarette Tubes, Originating In or Exported From France

- 1. This is to advise that on April 8, 2004, the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) concluded a review of the undertakings with respect to filter-tipped cigarette tubes, excluding those which bear the trademark or brand name of a finished or ready-made cigarette, originating in or exported from France, pursuant to the *Special Import Measures Act*.
- 2. The subject goods are normally imported into Canada under the following ten-digit Harmonized System classification number:

4813.10.00.00

3. The information collected in the course of the review was used to determine whether the undertakings continued to serve the purpose for which they were intended.

- 4. The CBSA concluded that there is a strong likelihood of the continuation or resumption of dumping should the undertakings be allowed to expire and that such a continuation or resumption of dumping would likely cause material injury to Canadian production of like goods. Accordingly, the President has concluded that the undertakings continue to serve their intended purpose. Therefore, the undertakings are being renewed for a further period of five years, that is, until April 7, 2009.
