

SECONDARY STUDENT CHECKLIST

The checklist aims to help secondary school students to identify concerns about bullying and harassment. When the checklist is completed it can be shared with an adult at school or at home.

Key: Y = Yes, N= No, U = Unsure

1. I have been taught things to say and do if I'm being bullied, teased or harassed				
2. The Student Code of Conduct helps to keep the school a safe and supportive place				
3. Students are involved in developing class and school rules				
4. When bullying happens at school, everyone knows what steps to take to solve it				
5. I feel confident to report bullying at school				
6. My teachers use and show us positive ways to communicate, to solve problems and to work well with others				
7. Staff are helpful when there are problems with bullying or harassment				
8. Some students don't report bullying because they believe it just makes things worse				
9. Teachers take it seriously when students report that they have been bullied				
10. Older students often bully or tease younger students				
11. My school cares if someone is absent because they have been bullied or harassed				
12. Some students who bully others are also bullied themselves				
13. I have been taught helpful things to do when I am in a conflict situation				
14. The school notices and lets us know when student relationships and behaviours are positive				
15. There is a 'code of silence' at this school that prevents bullying from being reported.				
16. My teachers demonstrate (model) the kind of behaviours that students are expected to show				
17. We have opportunities to develop positive relationships with other students through activities like cross-age tutoring, etc.				
18. I have recently been bullied at school				
19. The school is interested to find out what we think and feel about bullying and harassment				
20. My school cares about everyone's health and wellbeing				
21. I have witnessed other students being bullied at this school				
22. My teachers try to find out the reasons why a student might be bullying others				
23. There are some students I avoid because they are likely to bully me or my friends				
24. There are some places around the school I avoid so that I am not bullied				
25. We have regular classroom discussions on bullying and other issues and we work cooperatively to solve these problems.
