Ted Hughes agrees to investigate Yukon Workers' Compensation Health and Safety Board

The Yukon Workers' Compensation Health and Safety Board (YWCHSB) has contracted former Justice Ted Hughes Q. C. to conduct an investigation, as requested by Sue Edelman, Minister Responsible for the Workers' Compensation Health and Safety Board.

Hughes began conducting interviews for the investigation on Wednesday, May 1.

The investigation is to cover the period of time Edelman has been minister—from January 14, 2002 to present. The investigation report must be submitted to the minister by May 28, 2002. The minister has committed to tabling the report in the legislature.


