

Dear Ms Lenke,

It is my intention to appear before the Yukon Utilities Board as an intervener in the hearing of Yukon Energy Corporation's 20-Year Resource Plan.

I have an interest in all aspects of the proposed Resource Plan.

In particular, whether or not the proposed capital investments are prudent and to what extent such investments or procedural/policy (LOLE) changes can be expected to effect electrical rates for all customer classes. I have a great deal of concern about the business risks that YEC (and its existing customers) may well be exposed to through providing electrical service to new mining ventures. In my, as yet brief, review of YEC's submission, it appears that there exists a disconnect between the securing of financing from the mines for their fair share of the cost to deliver power and the mines also providing a fair share of the financing of the expansion of the generating capacity that can be expected to be required.
