Agricultural Producers' Organization Funding (Agency) Regulation

Regulation 179/2000

Registered December 21, 2000

Definitions

1 In this regulation,

"Act" means The Agricultural Producers' Organization Funding Act;

"three month period" means the three consecutive month period ending on the last days of February, May, August and November in each calendar year.

Maximum annual membership fee

2 For an individual, corporation or partnership, the maximum annual membership fee of the certified organization is \$133.75, inclusive of Goods and Services Taxes which may be payable respecting the fee.

Designated purchaser

- 3(1) Those persons listed in the Schedule to this regulation are designated purchasers.
- **3(2)** A body corporate affiliated with a person designated under subsection (1) is also a designated purchaser.
- **3(3)** A person who acquires title to or possession of an agricultural product as a principal or as an agent on behalf of a person designated under subsection (1) or (2) is also a designated purchaser.

Percentage value

4 The percentage value of an agricultural product that must be withheld under section 27 of the Act is .5% of the gross selling price payable by a designated purchaser for an agricultural product.

All persons making use of this consolidation are reminded that it has no legislative sanction. Amendments have been inserted into the base regulation for convenience of reference only. The original regulation should be consulted for purposes of interpreting and applying the law. Only amending regulations which have come into force are consolidated. This regulation consolidates the following amendments: 181/2001; 206/2002; 244/2004.

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Refund of underpayments

5 When the certified organization is required by subsection 28(1) of the Act to refund amounts withheld under section 27, it shall make the refund within 60 days of the end of its fiscal year.

Refunds of overpayments

When the certified organization is required by subsection 28(2) of the Act to refund amounts withheld under section 27, it shall refund the excess amount to the person from whom it was withheld within 60 days of the end of a three month period.

Refunds on request

When the certified organization is required by section 29 of the Act to refund the amounts withheld under section 27, it shall refund to the person making such request any amount remitted to it by a designated purchaser for that person within 60 days of the end of a three month period.

Minimum amounts excepted

8 The certified organization is not required to refund any amount under sections 5 or 6 which is less than \$50.00 prior to 90 days of the end of its fiscal year.

Coming into force and expiry

9 This regulation comes into force on January 1, 2001 and ceases to have effect on December 31, 2006.
