THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT (C.C.S.M. c. H60)

Commodities Transported by Armoured Car Designation Order

Regulation 84/89 Registered March 29, 1989

Definition

1 In this order, **"armoured car services"** shall mean services in the provision of which highly valuable commodities, such as coins, currency, cheques, precious metals, bonds, securities, are transported in a public service vehicle subject to special security measures.

Designation

2 Pursuant to subsection 289(1) of *The Highway Traffic Act* commodities transported in the provision of armoured car services are designated as commodities for the transportation of which a certificate may be issued to an applicant who is otherwise qualified without further findings under subsection 290(2).

Repeal

3 Manitoba Regulation 37/86 is repealed.

Coming into force

4 This regulation comes into force one week after the date of publication in *The Manitoba Gazette*.
