Reporting to the Regional Director you will be responsible for the overall management and delivery of the Department's Maintenance Management Program, including responsibility for efficient and effective Water, Sanitation system and associated municipal service activities. The Incumbent provides advice and support to communities on maintenance budgets and is responsible for the ongoing monitoring, analysis and refinement of maintenance policies and procedures. The position provides technical guidance and advice to the various Community Empowerment Initiative teams in all areas involving infrastructure transfers. Within the broad parameter of departmental policies, goals and objectives, the incumbent routinely makes final decisions regarding the relative priorities of program requirements.

To be successful in this role you should have a technical diploma and /or Inter-provincial Journeyman Certification or other relevant diploma/certification in a relevant trade plus 3 years related experience in a northern environment. Or a High School Diploma and 5 years experience in a municipal setting at a Foreman level or Maintenance Management Supervisor level. You should also have knowledge in job site safety, dangerous goods training and experience. Excellent communication and Interpersonal skill are also a must. Previous supervisory experience and the ability to speak Inuktitut/Inuinnaqtun would also be assets.
