INDUSTRY AND PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS

In Manitoba, the practices of professional engineering and professional geoscience are regulated under the *Engineering and Geoscientific*

Professions Act (June 29, 1998). Anyone who engages in the practice of these professions within the province must be a member of the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of the Province of Manitoba (APEGM).
