

INFORMATION REQUEST FOR SNOWMOBILE OWNERS IN THE QIKIQTAALUK AND KIVALLIQ REGIONS OF NUNAVUT

Purpose of the Form

This form is being used to gather information about snowmobiles that may have been affected by the use of gasoline in the Qikiqtaaluk and Kivalliq regions of Nunavut during the 2001 and 2002 winter.

The information may be used to help the Government of Nunavut determine what amount of compensation may be provided to snowmobile owners who have experienced problems associated with the consumption of gasoline.

The form is divided into 3 sections:

Section A personal information, Section B snowmobile information, and Section C description of the problems.

Section A

This section is used to identify the owner of a snowmobile.

Owners should provide their first and last or family name as well as their mailing address and, if possible, a telephone number which can be used to contact them.

The owner should indicate whether or not they belong to a Hunters and Trappers Organization and whether or not they are a beneficiary under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement.



Section B

This section is used to provide information about the snowmobile. If an individual owns more than one snowmobile please fill in a separate form for each machine and indicate at the top of the form that it is 1 of 2, 2 of 2 etc..

The owner is asked to provide the following information about the snowmobile:

Year and month of purchase

Make (Yamaha, Bombardier, Polaris, etc.),

Model (Bravo Renegade, etc.),

Year of manufacture,

Engine size (540cc, 600cc, etc.),

Plate number (if licensed in the hamlet, municipality, city),

Serial number, and

Odometer reading or estimate.

The owner is also asked to provide an estimate of the amount of time the snowmobile has been used during the 2001/2002 winters for hunting, guiding, outfitting, recreation and other purposes.

SECTION C

This section provides information about any problems the snowmobile owner may have encountered during the 2001 - 2002 winter.

Space is provided for the owner to describe what problems may have occurred with the machine. If the space provided is insufficient please attach a separate sheet.

The snowmobile owner is asked to answer a number of questions to determine what the owner did to deal with the problems.



The first question is whether or not the snowmobile was repaired during the past season.

If the snowmobile was not repaired the owner is asked whether it could be operated. If it could not be operated the owner is asked to indicate when this happened.

If repairs were carried out the owner is asked to indicate whether the repairs were done in a snowmobile repair shop or whether it was self repaired.

In both cases the owner is requested to provide copies of any invoices or bills associated with the repairs. For repairs not done in a repair shop, an estimate of the number of hours the owner worked on the machine himself should be provided.

Before signing and dating the form the snowmobile owner is asked to provide any details of problems that may have occurred with outboard motors in the fall of 2001.
