Procedures for Licensing Collection Agents

Under Parts VII and IX of the *Consumer Protection Act*, collection agents/agencies must be licensed and bonded prior to operating in the Northwest Territories.

The following are procedures to be used to obtain a Collection Agent Licence:

- 1. complete the application form;
- 2. Forward an original Surety Bond in the amount of \$5,000.00. BE SURE to use the wording supplied on our form (attached);
- 3. submit the required fee;
- 4. submit a list of your collectors and tracers, giving their full name, address and employment history for the previous ten years;
- 5. submit a list of your clients for whom you make collections in the NWT;
- 6. provide a copy of your Certificate of Good Standing from Legal Registries in Yellowknife (867)-873-7492;
- 7. resident collection agents must provide a copy of their Letter of Compliance from the Workers' Compensation Board (1-800-661-0792 or 867-920-3888); and
- 8. Obtain municipal licensing where required.

Fee Schedule

Individual licence:	\$100.00
Partnership licence	\$100.00 per partner to a maximum of \$300.00
Corporation licence	\$300.00

Licences are issued from April 1 and expire March 31 of the following year. Fees for licenses are for one year (or part thereof) and must be paid each year upon renewal.
