Procedures for Licensing Vendors

Under Parts VII and IX of the *Consumer Protection Act*, vendors must be licensed and bonded prior to operating in the Northwest Territories. Territorial legislation requires vendors with sales greater than \$50.00 to be licenced in the NWT.

The following are procedures to be used to obtain a Collection Agent Licence:

- 1. complete the application form:
- 2. have your bonding company complete the Penal Bond in the amount of \$5,000.00. BE SURE to use the wording supplied on our form (attached);
- 3. submit the required fee (listed below);
- 4. submit a list of direct sellers who will be working in the NWT;
- 5. provide a copy of your Certificate of Good Standing from Legal Registries in Yellowknife (867)-873-7492;
- 6. provide a copy of your Letter of Compliance from the Workers' Compensation Board (1-800-661-0792 or 867-920-3888); and
- 7. Obtain municipal licensing where required.

0 direct sellers: \$60.00 1-5 direct sellers: \$100.00 more than 5 direct sellers \$120.00

Licences are issued from April 1 and expire March 31 of the following year. Fees for licenses are for one year (or part thereof) and must be paid each year upon renewal.
