Various Ground Beef Products Sold in the NWT May Contain *E.coli* 0157:H7

YELLOWKNIFE (09 August, 04): Dr. Kami Kandola, acting Chief Medical Health Officer, is warning NWT residents that some ground beef products sold in the NWT with "best before" dates between **June 15 and June 24, 2004** may contain *E.coli* 0157:H7 bacteria and should not be eaten.

The following products distributed in the NWT by Extra Foods and Real Canadian Wholesale Club are affected by the recall:

- 1. Regular Ground Beef
- 2. Lean Ground Beef
- 3. Extra Lean Ground Beef

E.coli 0157:H7 typically causes diarrheal illness. In some cases it can cause serious and potentially life-threatening illness such as bloody diarrhea and kidney failure, especially in children.

Food contaminated with the bacteria may not look or smell spoiled. These products should not be consumed

To date, there have been no NWT cases of illness associated with this recall. Residents who have this product in their freezers should throw it away or return it to the store with its label.
