## **Student Leadership Conference on Prevention of Tobacco Use**

**Yellowknife** (October 18, 2006) - Junior High students from across the Northwest Territories (NWT) will be at Range Lake North School from October 20-22, 2006 for a conference on tobacco entitled *BLAST* (*Building Leadership for Action in Schools Today*) 2006. This unique conference focuses on prevention of tobacco use through leadership skills development.

The conference is a partnership between the Lung Association Alberta/NWT and the Department of Health and Social Services, with funding from Health Canada's Tobacco Control Program. This is the fifth year *BLAST* has been offered in the NWT. Groups of students from 15 NWT communities will be attending.

This year's conference features several engaging presenters including Georgina Lovell, author of a book on the tobacco industry and Shaine Peters, a youth advocacy facilitator.
