CASE MANAGER Competition #SR06/40

A seasoned individual with case management experience is required to join the Claims Services team. This position manages complex and long term claims. Responsibilities include assessing, developing and facilitating the medical and vocational rehabilitation needs of the injured worker to assist in return to gainful employment. To expedite an early and safe return to work, this position interacts with the injured worker, health professionals, workers' representatives, employers, families and others as identified.

The successful candidate should have a degree in health or social sciences with several years experience applying good research, communication, problem solving, analytical, evaluative and investigative skills. Salary ranges from \$37.66 to \$42.73 per hour (approx. \$73,437 - \$83,318 per annum), plus an annual northern allowance of \$12,159.

Entitlement Officer/Adjudicator Competition #SR06/41

The Entitlement Officer/Adjudicator analyzes and investigates incoming claims to determine entitlement. This position manages claims up to 6 weeks in duration and assigns the time loss major claims and progressive injury claims to the Case Managers.

The requirements for this position include a related college diploma, combined with directly related work experience. Other requirements include demonstrated analytical, evaluative, investigative, research and computer skills. Good communications (verbal and written) and interpersonal skills are also necessary. The salary ranges from \$34.52 to \$39.15 per hour (approx. \$67,314 - \$76,344 per annum, plus an annual northern allowance of \$12,159.

Equivalencies will be considered on a case by case basis.

Both positions require a satisfactory criminal records check.
