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FEATURE FILM DISTRIBUTION ASSISTANCE

a. Purpose

The Nova Scotia Film Development Corporation (the "Corporation") may contribute to the theatrical release costs of a Nova Scotia produced dramatic, documentary or animated feature film (the "Film"), in the form of a recoupable advance, with the goal of enhancing the marketing campaign for the Film and increasing the Canadian box office returns.

b. Eligible Applicants

- 1. Joint applications will be accepted from the Producer and the Distributor.
- 2. The Producer applicant must be a production company incorporated pursuant of the laws of Canada or the laws of the Province of Nova Scotia, whose principal business is the development and production of film and video programs for television broadcast, theatrical release, and general distribution.
- 3. A majority of the shares of the production company must be owned and controlled by Nova Scotia residents, or the production company or one of its wholly owned production companies must have a full production office facility based in Nova Scotia for at least 12 consecutive months immediately prior to the date of application.
- 4. The Distributor applicant must be a recognized company incorporated in Canada whose principal business is the distribution and release of film and television productions in Canada, that is acceptable to the Corporation, and which is not a related party to the Producer applicant (the "Canadian distributor").
- 5. The Producer applicant and the Distributor applicant must be in good standing with the Corporation.

c. Eligible Projects

- 1. The Film must be a dramatic, documentary or animated feature film production not less than 70 minutes in length.
- 2. The Producer applicant must have secured a theatrical release distribution commitment from a Canadian distributor and a commitment from Telefilm Canada to finance the production's theatrical release in Canada.
- 3. The Film must be owned and controlled by the Producer applicant. An exception may be made for international treaty or inter-provincial co-productions, on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. The Film must be one in which the Corporation has an Equity Investment.

d. Ineligible Productions

- 1. A Film in which the applicant production company, the principals of the company, and any related entities, are in default of any contractual obligations to the Corporation.
- 2. A Film that contains explicit sex, excessive violence, sexual violence or sexual exploitation or any matter which is libellous, obscene or in any other way unlawful or which, in the Corporation's opinion, does not comply with the spirit and intent of the Act to Incorporate the Nova Scotia Film Development Corporation.
- 3. A Film in which the applicants have failed to comply, in any manner, with the Corporation's policies, programs and guidelines.
- 4. A Film in which the applicants have deliberately misrepresented, failed to disclose information, or failed to provide documentation requested by the Corporation.

e. General Conditions

- 1. The Corporation's marketing advance may match the Canadian distributor's contribution to the marketing budget for release of the Film in Canada up to a maximum recoupable advance of \$50,000.
- 2. The Canadian distributor must be pre-approved by Telefilm Canada.
- 3. The minimum combined contributions by Telefilm Canada and/or the Canadian distributor to the Film's theatrical release must not be less than \$100,000.
- 4. The Film will be released theatrically in Halifax for not less than one week.
- 5. The marketing budget for the Film must include:
 - (a) The production of a short promotional trailer for the Film for release in Canadian theatres; and
 - (b) The production of a poster for the Film.
- 6. The Canadian distributor and the applicant production company must demonstrate that they have engaged in a meaningful consultation on the Film's release strategy.
- 7. The eligible costs associated with the marketing budget are those approved by Telefilm Canada

f. Recoupment of Advance

The Distributor will recoup 100% of its marketing advance on the first tier. After the distributor has fully recouped its financial contribution to the marketing budget and its minimum guarantee, the Corporation will then recoup 100% of its marketing advance, prior to any advance of net revenues to the applicant production company. Any overages in the final marketing costs will also be recouped after the Corporation.

g. Application Process

Applications are accepted during the Corporation's regular funding rounds, in the winter, spring and fall. Applicants must submit a completed application form, together with the required supporting materials and a \$100 plus HST non-refundable processing fee. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

h. Reporting Requirements

The Producer applicant and the Canadian distributor must maintain complete and accurate books of accounts and records relating to all aspects of the exploitation of the Film, and all revenue and payments received by the Canadian distributor in relation to the exploitation of the Film. Such books and records must be prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles applicable to the motion picture industry in Canada. A copy must be maintained in the applicant production company's Nova Scotia head office, where they may be viewed at any time by the Corporation.

- 10. Proof of Canadian content certification;
- 11. For both the NS Production Company and the Distribution Company please provide corporate information, as follows:
 - (a) *Most recent financial statement of applicant corporation and any related corporations;
 - (b) *Incorporation certificate and Memorandum and Articles of Incorporation;
 - (c) *Name, address, province of residency and number of shares (common and preferred) for all shareholders;
 - (* Note: This information will be kept confidential it must be provided for each application, if not on file with the Corporation. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure, prior to applying, that the information is on file with the Corporation.)
- 12. A final credit list for the completed production.
- 13. Letter of permission to discuss the project with other financial participants and broadcasters/distributors;
- 14. Any additional information relevant to this application.
