- ii. the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime, or
- iii. a theatre of war as a member of the Canadian Forces, or the armed forces of another Commonwealth country or a wartime ally of Canada or another Commonwealth country."

If the plate is to be jointly owned, both parties must sign the appropriate section of the form entitled "Application for Ownership, Permits and Plates". The registration fee for a veteran plate will be the standard fee associated with the class and weight of the vehicle being registered, plus an additional \$5 fee at the time of issuance.
