

Health and Safety Awards

The OH&S Division gives awards to organizations and persons for accomplishments in occupational health and safety. Currently, the following awards are available:

Millionaire Award:

For companies or departments who have worked more than one million person hours without a loss time injury.

Award of Honour:

For companies or departments who have worked without a loss time injury:

- 1) more than one year, or;
- 2) between 40 000 and one million person hours.

Citation Award:

For companies or departments employing fewer than 20 persons who have worked more than one year without a loss time injury.

Educational Accident Prevention Award:

For educational institutions that have completed a full school term without a loss time injury.

Commendation for Improvement Award:

For companies or departments who have shown improvement on a quarterly basis in such things as:

- 1) reduction in injuries;
- 2) improved housekeeping;
- 3) efforts of the Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee
- 4) other meritorious activities.

Special Award:

Awarded on the recommendation of the Executive Director to any organization or individual deserving special recognition for their efforts in occupational health and safety.
