

The Off-highway Vehicle Infrastructure Fund



On April 1, 2006 a new annual fee was established to provide funding for programs and services for the users of Off-highway Vehicles (OHVs). If it applies to you, this user fee is paid at the time you initially register or renew your annual permit.

Riders who operate OHVs for recreational purposes on property other than their own must pay this \$40 fee. The fund will be used only for OHV programs and services such as:

- **safety training and environmental education**
- **trail development**
- **funding of off-highway vehicle user organizations**

The Nova Scotia Off-highway Vehicle Ministerial Advisory Committee advises on the use of the fund.

Remember – OHV Safety Training isn't just a good idea, it's the law!
