

Winter Safety Tips



Don't drive during a storm. Check road conditions: 1-800-307-SNOW or on the internet at www.gov.ns.ca/tran



Watch out for "black ice" when temperatures are just under or just above freezing.



Adjust your speed to conditions. If driving slowly pull over to let those behind pass.



Follow traffic at a safe distance and don't pass a snow plow that is clearing snow from the road.



Keep your vehicle in top working order and equipped with proper winter tires that are in good condition.



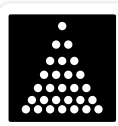
Have a winter survival kit in your vehicle.



Don't plow or shovel snow from your driveway into the road.



Don't park on the roadside.



Did You Know? *Salt is not an effective de-icer when temperatures drop below -10°C during the day, or below -7°C at night. That's why we do not apply salt when temperatures drop that low.*
