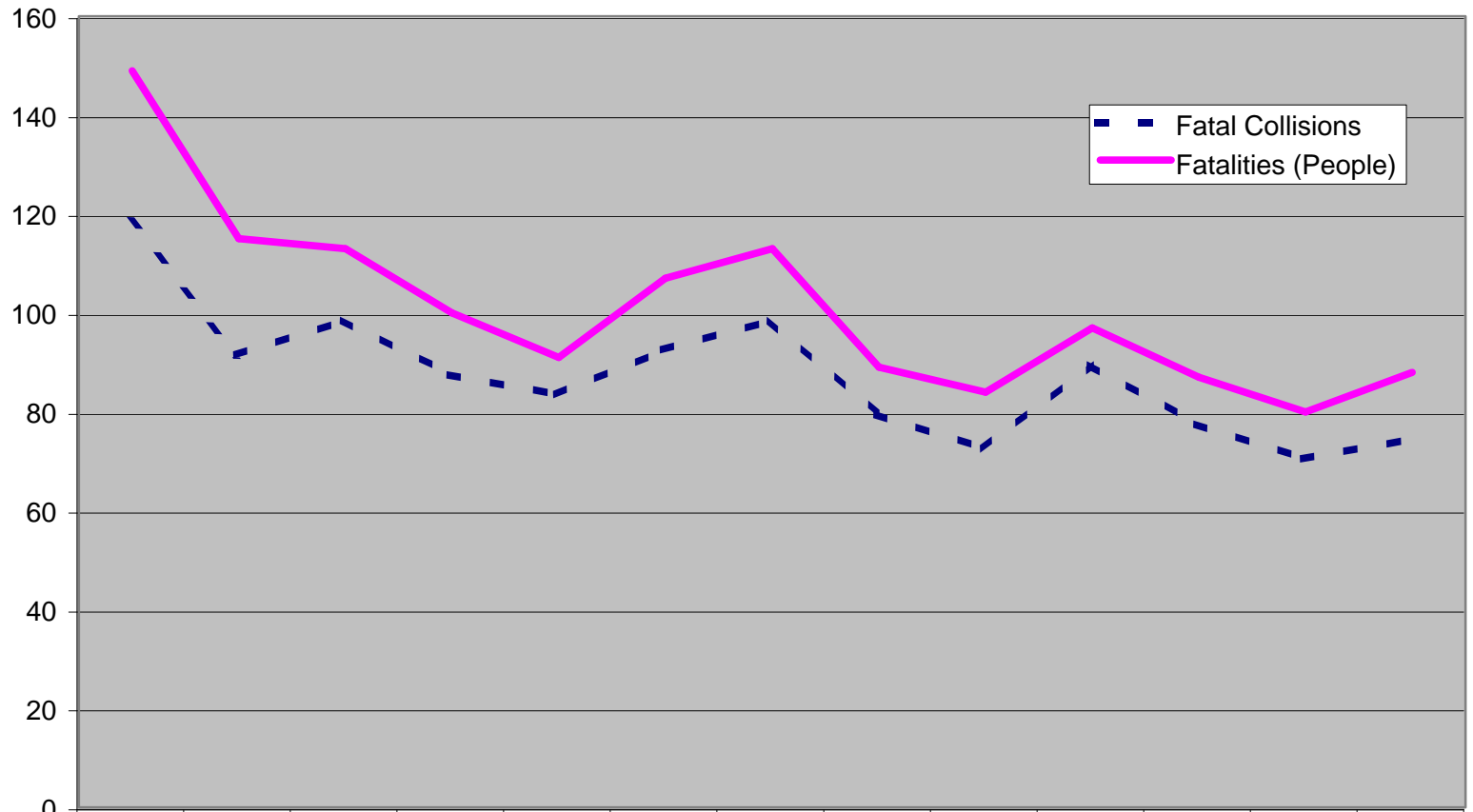

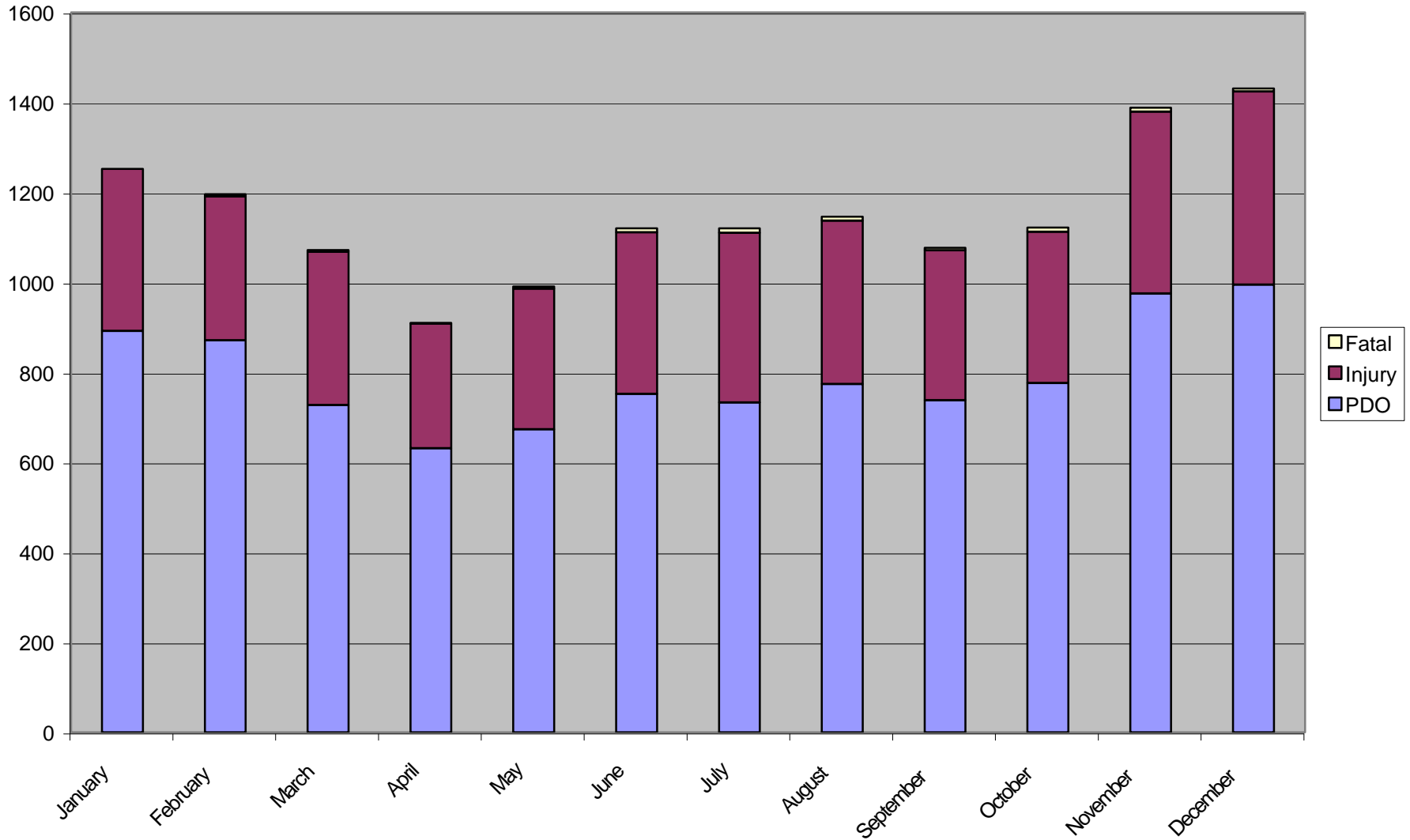

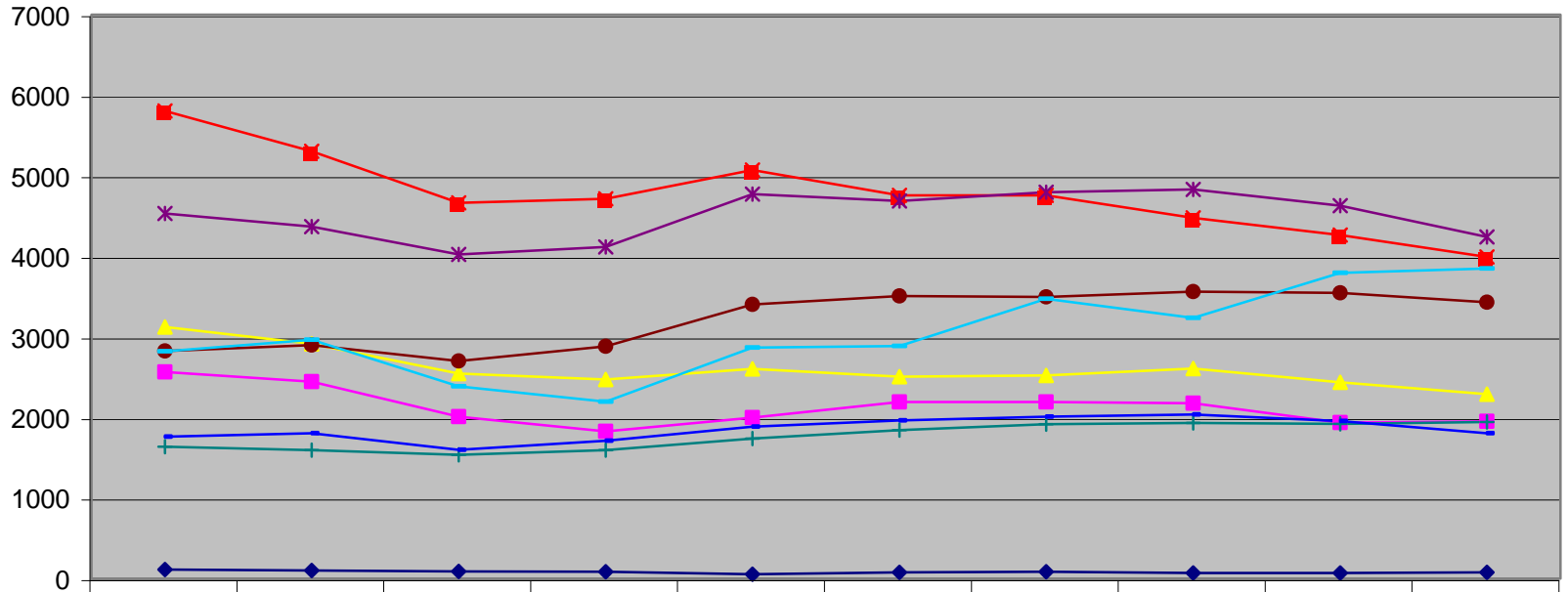

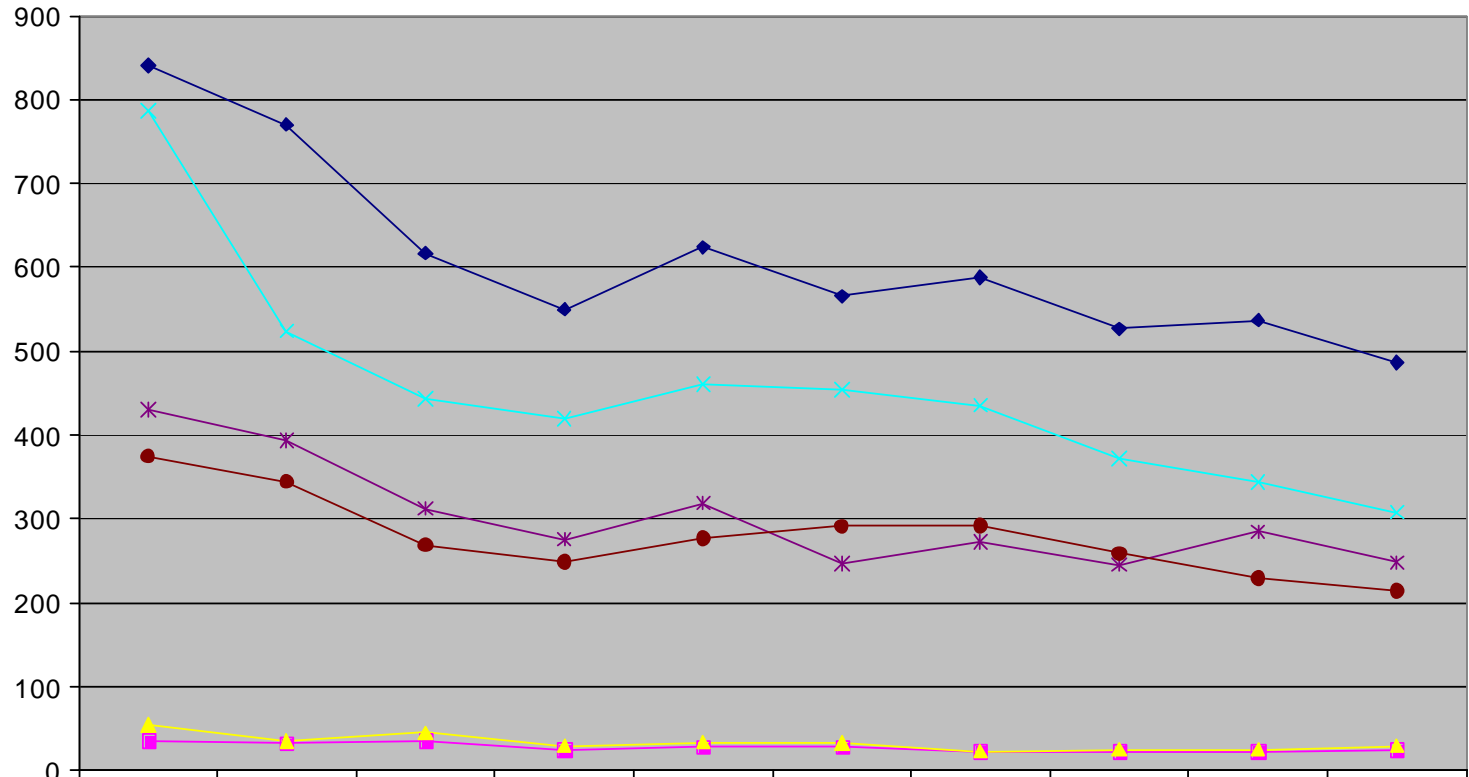


Drivers Involved in Collisions by Age
