Halifax Global Nova Scotia Nominee Program Fee Review Report

Please Note: There have been fee changes at both the federal and provincial levels, which impact the Nova Scotia Nominee Program, since the completion of the fee review report. The Halifax Global report references the former fees. The changes are outlined below.

Provincial Fees

On May 9, 2006, the government of Nova Scotia eliminated the provincial portion of the fees charged to potential immigrants applying for citizenship through the Nova Scotia Nominee Program.

On July 1, 2006, the fee for the Skilled worker category was eliminated. The current fee structure is:

Skilled Worker category: \$0

Community Identified category: \$0

Economic category: Undergoing review that is expected to result in a redesign

and the elimination of all application and processing fees. The province will not be accepting any new applications under the economic category for the balance of the 2006

calendar year.

Federal Fees

In May 2006 the government of Canada reduced the Right of Landing fees from \$975 to \$490.

Erratum

On pages 14, 26 and 27, the report incorrectly identifies the Prince Edward Island Skilled Worker category as having a \$1,500 fee. There are no fees for applying under this category.
