The data product supplied under this agreement shall at all times remain under the control of the institution. It may not be sold, rented, leased, lent, sub-licensed or transferred to any other institution or organization, and may not be traded or exchanged for any other product or service. The data product may not be used for the personal or commercial gain of any authorized user, nor to develop or derive for sale any other data product that incorporates or uses any part of this data product.

This data product is provided 'as-is', and the owner makes no warranty, either express or implied, including but not limited to warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. In no event will the owner be liable for any indirect, special, consequential or other damages however caused resulting from the use of the product.

A licence administrator shall be identified within the educational institution and will be responsible for the management of the data product and communication of these terms and conditions to all authorized users. The administrator will ensure that the use of this data product complies with these terms and seek prior written permission from Statistics Canada for any uses not permitted or not specified in this agreement. The license administrator is responsible for distributing the institution's username and password to authorized personnel only; it shall not be posted on an internet website. It is a condition of this agreement that only authorized users shall have access to this information. Failure to comply with any terms of this agreement will result in termination, without notice, of this agreement.
