# MANITOBA AGRI-FOOD EXPORTS, TO THE UNITED STATES, 1993 - 2004

- Preliminary data show Manitoba exports to the US at \$1.54 billion in 2004, 1.5% more than in 2003, but still 3.2% below the record \$1.59 billion in 2002.
- Manitoba's agri-food exports to all destinations were \$3.405 billion in 2004, down from \$3101.4 billion in 2003.
  The US accounted for 45.2% of Manitoba's total exports in 2004, down from 48.9% in 2003, including 16.4% of
- the total unprocessed exports, 85.7% of the semi-processed exports, and 64.8% of the processed exports.
  Combined hog and pork exports to the US dipped in 2002, but increased 7.7% between 2002 and 2003 and
- 7.8% between 2003 and 2004. Hog and pork exports to the US totaled \$549.3 million in 2004, which included virtually all hogs and 46% of total pork exports to all destinations.
- Live ruminant exports were halted following confirmation of bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) in a cow in Alberta on May 20, 2003. In September, 2003, a number of countries, including the US and Mexico, allowed a resumption of imports of specified Canadian boneless beef products. Live animal exports to the US were not resumed until July 2005.
- US import tariffs were imposed on Canadian wheat during 2003, beginning March 4 at 3.94%, and increasing by August 29 to 14.15% on Spring wheat and to 13.55% on Durum wheat. The Durum tariffs were removed on October 4, 2003, while the Spring wheat tariffs were maintained. A NAFTA trade panel has ordered the US International Trade Commission (ITC) to reconsider the tariffs.

## Unprocessed/Bulk:


- Unprocessed or bulk exports accounted for 18.8% of Manitoba's total exports to the US in 2004. Bulk exports, primarily field crops, were valued at \$289.8 million, 1.1% more than in 2003.
- In 2004, bulk oat exports totaled \$113.8 million, while bulk wheat exports were \$7.6 million.
- In 2004, Manitoba exported \$59.4 million in bulk canola to the US, but imported \$187.1 million worth of US canola for seed and crushing.

#### Semi-Processed/Intermediate:

- Semi-processed exports accounted for 49.7% of the total exported to the US, and were primarily products from hogs, canola oil and meal, and pulse crops. Exports were a near-record \$767 million, 4.1% more than 2003.
- Canola oil exports were \$185.1 million with meal exports of \$61.0 million, a combined increase of 29.4% over 2003. That represents 96.3% of Manitoba's total canola oil exports and all of the meal exports.
- Manitoba's live cattle and bison exports were all attributed to direct US shipments. These dropped to \$106.7 million in 2003, less than 40% of the 2002 value, and to zero in 2004. In 2003, an estimated 97,354 head of live cattle were exported to the US, 37% of 2002.
- Exports of hogs to the US were valued at \$352.4 million in 2004, 27.6% more than in 2003, virtually all of Manitoba's hog export value.

## Processed/Consumer:

- Processed exports accounted for 31.5% of Manitoba's total exports to the US, and were primarily potato products, pork and honey. Processed exports totaled \$485 million in 2004, 2.2% less than 2003.
- Approximately 46.1% of Manitoba's processed pork exports go to the US and virtually all processed beef. Processed pork exports totaled \$196.9 million in 2004, 15.6% less than in 2003, while processed beef exports totaled only \$3.6 million, an increase of 38.6%.
- Processed potato exports to the US totaled a record \$239.6 million in 2004, 18.9% more than in 2003, and 93% of Manitoba's total processed potato exports to all destinations, compared to 98% in 2003.
