Policy Renewal Goals

- To clarify through a renewed policy suite, the management responsibilities and accountabilities of Ministers and Deputy Heads, distinguishing between their duties and those of functional experts.
- To create an integrated, streamlined and consolidated policy infrastructure.

Established Governance process


- Portfolio Policy Renewal Steering Committee and Management Policy and Oversight Committee (MPOC);
- Policy Council, HRMIC, HRMAC;
- Policy Renewal Directorate (TBS) and PSHRMAC Policy Renewal Team;
- All policy centers now engaged in renewal exercise.

Work plan developed and monitored


- Inventory of all existing policy instruments;
- List of proposed policy instruments for end state of policy suite;
- Proposed timelines provided for completion of renewed policies;
- Performance reporting/monitoring progress of each policy.




Pre-Renewal Policy Suite

Accomplishments to Date

Definitions & tools developed

- Approved definitions for different policy instruments;
 (Frameworks, Policy, Directives, Standards) (See Annex A)
- Approved policy development challenge questions
 - the right policy instruments are developed for the right reasons;
 - the instruments are clearly articulated to meet project and management objectives, and
 - the instruments' impact have been assessed and addressed
- Policy development guide and template to assist drafting of policies;

- Policy capacity being strengthened
 - Training on writing policies for the web was piloted
 - Training on policy development for TB portfolio policy writers underway
 - Plain language training for policy writers underway

Communications

- Deputy heads and bargaining units informed of project and its objectives;
- Presentations to Treasury Board ministers;
- Presentations to staff including sessions with PSHRMAC Policy Council, TB portfolio policy analysts, HRPAD and Communications Branch;
- Policy database being developed;
- Approved policy instruments and communicated to Deputy Heads and functional communities;

Challenges

- Coordinating comprehensive consultations with stakeholders;
- Policy development within changing context (i.e., Federal Accountability Action Plan);
- Building up policy development capacity in some policy centres;
- Ensuring that policy centres engage in profound renewal aligned with project objectives;
- Ensuring that TB policies do not encourage more departmental rules



Challenges (cont'd)

- Ensure reporting requirements are streamlined, and coordinated with Management Accountability
 Framework;
- Managing change both internally and externally;
- Implementing web-tools and maximizing their use.

Structure of TB Policy Instruments

Instrument	Description	Application
Framework	Provides strategic context, explains why TB sets policy	Architectural
Policy	Formal direction explaining what Deputies are expected to achieve	Mandatory
Directive	Instructions on <i>how</i> Deputies and officials must act to meet policy	Mandatory
Standard	Detailed technical instructions, procedures on how a function is conducted	Mandatory
Guideline / Tool	Variety of documents, databases and tools used by specialists or employees in day-to-day duties	Voluntary

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
