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
Garrison Woods, Calgary

> CLC Objectives

- To support affordable housing policies of City of Calgary and advance residential zoning for CLC site
- Details
 - CLC transferred land and surplus PMQ's to City for nominal amount, supervised development of site
- > Results
 - City established 65 affordable housing units (semi-detached and singles)
 - CLC site rezoned residential

> Objectives

- To provide a range of rental and home ownership housing options on the site;
- To target affordability at the median income for the NDG area

> Details

- > Land acquired by co-ops at market value;
- Land for home ownership acquired through HRSDC

Results

530 residential units created – 200 subsidized rentals, 225 home ownership (co-op), balance are market units

> Objectives

- CLC to finalize land sale
- Options for Homes to develop affordable condominium apts. (380) and townhouses (51)

Details

 CLC sold the site to Options for Homes with preferred financing and increased risk to CLC (less amount of money down, assumed a second mortgage)

Results

CLC sold land at market value, Options for Homes project sold out successfully





McLevin Woods, Toronto

> Objectives

- CLC support affordable housing in Toronto, finalize land sale
- Habitat for Humanity affordable housing for low income families

> Details

- PWGSC paid for the land under HRSDC SRPHI program
- Habitat for Humanity acquired the site for \$1.00

> Results

CLC sold land at market value, Habitat delivered 43 affordable town homes

> Objectives

To support Affordable Housing policies of OP, sell land at market value

Details

- PWGSC paid for the land (\$800,000) under HRSDC SRPHI program
- City of Ottawa acquired the site for \$1.00

Results

CLC sold land at market value, City to transfer land to Mclean Co-op for 49 affordable apartments and 14 townhouses

PMQ Rentals

PMQ housing is maintained as a rental pool during initial development phases - unique supply of single family housing at reasonable rents

CLC also adding secondary suites in new projects (e.g. Griesbach, Edmonton)
