CADET INSTRUCTOR AWARDED SCHOLARSHIP

ESQUIMALT, B.C. - Captain Trevor Henderson, Commanding Officer of 2893 Seaforth Highlanders of Canada Royal Canadian Army Cadet Corps (RCACC) in Port Coquitlam has been awarded the 15-hundred dollar Cadet Instructor Cadre Citizen Scholarship. The Scholarships are awarded annually to two members of the Canadian Forces Cadet Instructor Cadre who are pursuing their first post secondary degree or diploma. A selection is made based on character, and leadership qualities/potential, scholarship, and financial need.

Capt. Henderson grew up in Langley, B.C. and as a teenager was a member of 2812 Seaforth Highlanders of Canada RCACC of Surrey, B.C. He graduated from the corps as Cadet Warrant Officer. In the summer of 1991 he was appointed the Cadet Regimental Sergeant Major at the Vernon Cadet Summer Training Centre and was the senior cadet for the summer.

In 1992 he enrolled in the Canadian Forces to be an officer with 1922 Royal Westminster Regiment RCACC in Aldergrove, B.C. and was eventually the Commanding Officer for six years before transferring back to his original corps in Surrey in 2004. He was appointed Commanding Officer at Port Coquitlam in June of this year. He has also served in a variety of capacities at the Cadet Summer Training Centres in Vernon and Whitehorse.

In his civilian occupation he has been engaged in the retail business for a decade before recently returning to school. He is currently enrolled in the Public Relations Program at Kwantlan College in Richmond, B.C. He presently resides in Aldergrove.
