About the Implementation of ICD-10-CA/CCI Coding System

The International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems – Tenth Revision was adopted by the World Health Organization in 1990. It is the most recent revision of an international classification system used for classifying mortality and morbidity statistics.

ICD-10-CA is the enhanced Canadian version of the 10th revision of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems. ICD-10-CA replaces earlier ICD-9 and ICD-9-CM classifications.

In fiscal year 2001/02, five jurisdictions, namely British Columbia, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland, the Yukon and certain facilities in Saskatchewan, implemented the new ICD-10-CA/CCI classification. The remaining provinces and territories submitted 2001/02 data in ICD-9 or ICD-9-CM. The ICD-10_CA/CCI classification system is considerably different from the previously used ICD-9/CPP and ICD-9-CM classification systems, which are relatively comparable. This poses analytical and reporting challenges.

The remainder of Saskatchewan, as well as Ontario, Alberta, Northwest Territories, and Nunavut [implemented] ICD-10-CA/CCI in the fiscal year 2002/03; New Brunswick will begin submitting abstracts in ICD-10-CA/CCI in the 2003/04 DAD; Manitoba will submit in ICD-10-CA/CCI in fiscal 2004/05. Efforts are underway for Quebec to adopt the ICD-10-CA coding system.

In an effort to produce nationally comparable data in the interim, CIHI created conversion tables to map ICD-10-CA diagnosis and CCI interventions back to

ICD9/CPP. In some cases, where a direct one-to-one conversion was not possible, the conversion tables use a best "force fit" of diagnostic codes, and comparability inevitably is compromised. Users who are analyzing specific diagnoses or interventions over time are strongly advised to be prudent in their analytical approach by first analyzing data in their original classification scheme (e.g., ICD-10_CA/CCI) before utilizing the conversion tables. CIHI has endorsed the recommendation of the World Health Organization (WHO) in regards to ICD-10, which states that data analysis be conducted in the original classification system in which data were coded, and that converted data be used (if at all) with caution (Canadian Institute for Health Information, *Coping with the Introduction of ICD-10_CA and CCI*, July 2003).

Methodology and Data Limitations

General Notes

The Hospital Morbidity Database (HMDB) captures information on patients separatedthrough discharge or death- from and acute-care facility in Canada.

Hospital morbidity statistics reflect the number of hospitalizations (or discharges), which is somewhat higher than the number of individuals hospitalized since individuals with multiple admissions during a single year would be counted more than once in the discharge totals.

The year represents the fiscal year of discharge; for example, discharges in fiscal 2001 occurred between April 1, 2001 and March 31, 2002.

Figures [are] based on the number of discharges who were admitted to an acute-care facility and subsequently discharged (alive or dead) from that facility. Outpatient (e.g., same day surgery) and Emergency Department visits are not part of the Hospital Morbidity Database.

Figures are based on patient geography, that is, where the patient lives. Figures include Canadian residents only. In other words, individuals from other countries admitted to Canadian hospitals are not included. Patient residence was based on postal code. <u>Special Note:</u> Individuals from an ICD-9 submitting province who are seen in a facility located in an ICD-10-CA submitting province will be coded with ICD-10 codes. As a result, there will be ICD-10-CA counts from ICD-9 provinces, corresponding to residents seen outside that province. Likewise, individuals from an ICD-10_CA submitting province who are seen in a facility located in an ICD-10_CA submitting province who are seen in a facility located in an ICD-9 submitting province will be coded with ICD-10_CA submitting province who are seen in a facility located in an ICD-9 submitting province will be coded with ICD-9 codes. As a result, there will be ICD-9 counts from ICD-9 counts from ICD-9 counts from ICD-10-CA provinces.

Figures are in five year age categories, starting at the 15-19 year age group. Therefore, newborns and children under the age 15 are not included, unless specified [e.g., ICD-9 code 760.7 and ICD-10-CA code P04.4, are fetus and newborn specific- these codes were extracted for persons less than or equal to one year of age].

Figures include discharges with known gender only (i.e., discharges with unknown gender are excluded).

Figures include discharges with a known mode of separation only (i.e., discharges with unknown mode of separation are excluded).

Cell sizes of less than 5 cannot be released and have been suppressed with an asterisk (*). Codes with values of zero have been reported with the data, and will appear as '0'. Therefore, the suppressed cells have counts between 1 and 4.

For total counts, cell sizes of greater than or equal to 5 but less than or equal to 30 have been labeled as N/R for "Not Releasable" due to possible and/or real residual disclosure.

The Most Responsible Diagnosis identifies the most significant condition for the patient while in hospital and/or the condition responsible for the longest length of stay. To be counted as "Most Responsible Diagnosis", the applicable diagnosis code must appear in the first position of the discharge abstract. To be counted as "Diagnosis other than Most Responsible", the applicable diagnosis code may appear in any position (2-16 position on the ICD-9 and ICD-9-CM abstract, 2-25 position on the ICD-10-CA abstract) on the abstract, other than the first position (the Most Responsible Diagnosis).

Nunavut did not submit data to CIHI in fiscal year 2002/03. Therefore, discharges from Nunavut hospitals are not present in the analysis for 2002/03. Nunavut did submit data in fiscal year 2001/02, and has been included in this year.

Each fiscal year contains data in both ICD-9 and ICD-10-CA. Data were extracted in either ICD-9 or ICD-10-CA depending on the classification system used to capture the original data...It is extremely important that direct comparisons and trending between ICD-9 and ICD-10-CA are not performed, as the codes are not always directly comparable. [As was previously stated,] The ICD-10-CA/CCI classification system is considerably different from the previously used ICD-9/CCP and ICD-9-CM classification systems.
